

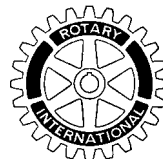

- Rotary International gives a lot: Annual Fund is \$12,454,000 and Permanent Fund is 3,855,000
- The vision of Rotary foundation work is a worthy one. It helps so many, from rescuing poor children from some of the pain associated with poverty to the continuing education of educators and business people.
- Warren also described how the various funds worked and how to donate to them
- He urged club members to be generous - the vision and work have life changing effects!
